EDITOR'S EDGE

Dear Sears Family Members:

It's still hard to get one of these newsletters put together but I have not figured out any other way to publish all of your hard work. At this writing we have 65 members in the association of which, 20 are libraries. I trust they will catalogue the information for future generations. I've also decided to start a new section SUPPLEMENTAL SEARS' which will be about families which are not connected to the Descendants of Richard (yet). There are many SEARS families in the country with origins from Virginia (probably English) and Kentucky (ZAHER from Swiss/German Stock). There are even some mid-west families with connections to French-Canadian CYR families. All of these have anglicized their spelling to SEARS. We also find SAYERS, SEERS, SARES, and other variations which could all be related when we consider 18th century spelling variations.

Mark Twain said "They spell it Vinci and pronounce it Vinchy; foreigners always spell better than they pronounce." I believe Andrew Jackson said "It's a poor mind indeed that cannot come up with at least two ways to spell a word." When we visited the Bahamas a friendly doctor that my Mom met said "where'd you get a good old Bahama name like Say'-yars." The English accent and pronunciation probably hasn't changed over the years. I believe a famous Sears was Chief of Police of Nassau.

There are still copies of the First Edition of the Sears Genealogical Catalogue left if you know a relative who would like one. Just send me \$48 or call with a VISA/MC number. My wife says I can't start working on the second edition until they are gone!

We would like to get more portrait shots of SEARS but they are hard to reproduce here. It may take a special photo album to get them done correctly. I could try scanning them into the computer to see if the popular photo retouch programs could make them desktop publishable. Dick Elderkin recently published SEARS NOTES and we will include information about descendants from Eleazar and Sarah (Wheaton) Sears (No. 3055)in the next newsletter. Dick is looking for photos of Eleazar and his son Isaac.

I must apologize to Merna Sears, Jamestown, NY for leaving her hard work out of our original volume. The names really start to swim before my eyes and despite computers to print and check it comes down to a person to make everything right. I messed up but you will find her families line in this issue including the latest great-grandchild Ian (No. 11283 ja). This is an active branch as their daughter organized a reunion in Warren, PA last fall which was attended by 49 members of the clan.

I have been surfing the information superhighway (aka INFOBAHN, or I-WAY) and found some cousins (Including Admiral Sears, data to follow) and much genealogy information. One fact is that there are eleven geographical Since I have changed the way I document information, it is now easier to see who was the contributor of each item. Besides the information from Merna Sears, we are publishing information from Bill Cooper in Tenn and Diane Brigode in Colo. Diane goes to great lengths to verify all of her work before she sends it in for publication. My first cousins had their first baby (No.9147a) so now all six of us on the Sears side have descendants. MD refers to the Mayflower Descendant's periodical which was contributed by Perry Row, OK001 is data which came from a computer file from Brian Smith and the Knowles Genealogy provided by the daughter of Arlie Kreuger. The first hand accounts from Miss Leila Sears about her family lend a special touch to our locations on the continent derived from SEARS: Sears, Hendry co, FL

collection. And of course our newly found cousin Admiral Scott Sears has graciously furnished his family branch details to bring his line up to date.

I correspond with hundreds of people via electronic mail (e-mail) and US Mail (snail mail) and I am not always very current with answering the mail. There is still a tremendous amount of data to be presented to you and its hard to acknowledge all of your hard work.

I hope you will accept this word of thanks and keep the information coming. We have many more broken branches on the tree which need your repairs. Even if you don't want to furnish details of dates and places, a simple

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connection of parent to child is more than welcome. It is very difficult to document the present day genealogies and the census of the future won't make this work any easier. I also keep a name and address (and a few phone numbers) database of Sears across the country which I derive from phone books, computer links, Sears Across America books, et al so if you collect any of this type information I would be glad to trade with you. There are 8,600 names of contemporary Sears in this database, many names are duplicated but it may serve to show migration and location of Sears in future years as we add information to the list. As you can see by the numbers in brackets [24688] which are assigned by my genealogy program we are approaching 25,000 Sears relatives in our "tree." Some estimate that there may be more Sears alive right now than the sum of all those who have lived in past history. Also if anyone wants any of this data (genealogical or name and address) in "electronic format" we can provide Wordperfect, DBase, PAF GEDCOM, ASCII text or name your poison (MS/IBM-DOS any size disk, MAC poses a slight problem but we'll work on it.)

I'm sorry for the delay in getting the newsletter out but I have been trying to be very careful about getting copyright clearances before publishing. We are not very widely distributed yet but, I hope by being conscientous about putting the credit where it's due, that others will feel comfortable about adding to our family's history. OK001 - Computer files from Brian Smith-Paul **Knowles** settled at Truro where he took a postion in line with his family standing. While evidently avoiding permanent town offices, except for serving one year as selectman, he repeatedly headed special committees by choice of the parish and the Truro proprietors. On his death, his real estate was settled on his sons, Paul and Silas, who were to pay their portions to the other heirs, including four living brothers and sisters and the children of the three not living. Admin on his estate granted 11 Apr 1775.

Perkins, July 31, 1789: Mr Alden **Sears**, in an old York schooner, comes in from fishing. Mr **McAlpine**, the D. Naval Officer, ordered Mr **Sears** out of the River & came to me on the subject. I told him the weather was too bad, & that I would see about it in the morning.

In 1787 the names of persons who had left the town and county were published, and their lands forfeited. Many of these sympathized with the American side of the Revolution, and for that reason returned to the United States. Others returned before the war was contemplated. Among the names is Alden **Sears**. For full list see over #2419 Samuel **Battles**.

Long, page 60, re real estate transactions: Oct 13, 1764, Daniel **Eldridge** to Alden **Sears**, "both of Liverpool", house, etc.

Long, Page 369 says that Alden and Nathan Sears went back to Cape Cod.

His daily journals have been published: The Diary of Simeon **Perkins**, ed. H A **Innis**, D C **Harvey** and C B **Fergusson** (Toronto: Champlain Society, 1948-58, 5 vols). **'Long**' refers to Robert James **Long**, a Queens County historian, his Annals of Liverpool and Queens County 1760-1867 (West Medford, MA, 1926) was privately circulated in an unpublished format."]

BIRTH-FATHER-SPOUSE-CHILDREN-DEATH-BIOGRAPHY: Samuel Pearce May, THE DESCENDANTS OF RICHARD SARES(SEARS) OF YARMOUTH,MASS; 1638-1888; Albany, Joel Munsell's Sons, 1890; p 120; NEHGS Library, Boston, MA; [This is repeated from the original catalogue for information] Alden **Sears**, "yeoman," of Rochester, resided for a time in Nova Scotia, and was one of the grantees of the town of Liverpool in 1761. His wife dying, he returned to the States, living for a time in Pawtucket and Providence, engaged in boat-building and distilling. He had been previously a seaman, and is said to have commanded a whaling vessel before he was of age.

Marrying again, he settled in Dighton, MA, on the old **Walker** homestead, which on the death of her father, fell to his wife. The old house is still standing near 200 years old, and is a good specimen of the early colonial times.

About commencement of the Revolutionary War he resumed his voyages, and in returning from the West Indies with a cargo of molasses was captured by the British, lost his vessel and cargo, and was held prisoner several years.

An English officer, with whom he made friends, finally procured his release and supplied him with funds for his return.

His wife is said to have had full faith during all the years of his absence that he would return, although others had given him up as dead. According to the superstitions of the times, there were many signs convincing her that he would return. One evening in her teacup, the peculiar position of the leaves was proof that he was then on his way home. She rose hastily, saying "Alden will be home to-night, and I must put the house in order, and dress and go to meet him." Upon opening the door, she really saw him in the distance approaching the house.

They removed to Bristol, NY in 1792, with others from the vicinity of Dighton. For his land he paid six cents an acre.

He was in Capt Elijah **Walker's** Co., in Col John **Hathaway's** Regt, and marched on "ye alarm of 2 Aug 1780, to Tiverton, 18 miles' travel, 7 days' service, wages £1.8.0."

Crowell's Hist Barrington, page 553: Josiah **Sears** was an early arrival from Cape Cod though not a grantee. He was a brother of Mrs Theodore **Harding** gr, and married (a) Anna **Crowell** of Chatham and (b) Phebe, sister of Wm **Adams**, Sr.

He lived for a while on Sherose Id where he owned the **Lincoln** Lot; but sold it and moved up to Shag Harbour about 1792. Mr **Sears** was the ostensible informer against absconding grantees whose titles were forfeited in 1784. In the Third Division Josiah **Sears** Sr drew lot 89, laid off to Prince **Freeman**, near Brass Hill.

Although father had a 'tin ear,' describing all music as 'an expensive form of noise,' EHS 2nd was very musical, overcoming ill-fitted piano hands learned to play very well. Each of his wives played reasonably well on the violin, and both his sons played well on the piano, especially John.

His business career began in shoe manufacture at Brockton, MA, and he later moved into textiles. For many years he was a Director of Wellington Sears / West Point Mfg/ later West Point Pepperell (made MARTEX products) of which Horace Scudder **Sears** (4234) had been a founding officer.

EHS 2nd, meanwhile, in partnership with a Mr **Willett**, established the American Felt & Belting Co of Boston. Among other products, they furnished felt for Mason & Hamler pianos which entailed furnishing the long hinge for the pianos. The same hinge coincidentally was found useful on the hood of the Packard Motor Cars, then in full glory.

The AF & B Co flourished until a major litigation exploded; **Willett** vs **Herrick** wound up as the second longest in verbiage and recorded pages of all the annals of Massachusetts courts. Basically it related to a sell-out, sub rosa, of controlling stock in Daniel Green Shoe Co (bedslippers) still being produced elsewhere. Decided in their favor in lower court, the case reversed in Mass Supreme Court. It seems that Mr **Willett** was in on the plot.

Moved from Hardy co, WV to Greene co, TN about 1786 and in 1787, upon affidavit of Johns **Seers** and Joseph **Scott**, the Greene co sheriff was directed to return **Sears**, **Scott** and John **Smith** insolvent. **Sears** was appointed Greene co road overseer at Henry **Conway's** house on 3 Nov 1789 [3-Goldene Burgner, Greene co, TN Court of Common Pleas, pp 135, 193, 232, 415].

At a meeting in John **Sears'** room in Feb 1791, Joseph **Conway** was made overseer of the road from Bird's Hill to Mat **Pate's** Hill.

Sears, an assignee of Martin Armstrong, the surveyor of land for soldiers, was granted 120 acres north of Nolichucky River "joining his former survey" and adjoining Mathew **Pate's** grant, on 4 Feb 1795 [4-NC Land Grants Filed in Greene co, Vol 5, p 122. Goldene Burgner, North Carolina Land Grants Recorded in Greene Co, TN, 1981, p 150. Grant 261, George **Brock**, 211 acres; #282, 383, 390 Mathew **Pate**, 372 acres, Greene co, 20 Sep 1787, north side Nolichucky. Zedikiah **Sears** was made overseer of the road from **Pate's** Hill to Darby **Ragan's** place in Nov 1795 [3-pp 135,193,232,415] In 1796 he served on a jury. He was on the 1797 Grainger co, TN tax roll, the 1806 Anderson co, TN roll and - as "**Seers**" -on the 1812 Greene co, TN roll [6-A John **Sears** was on Bledsoe co's 1815 roll].

On 4 Apr 1812, John L Sears sold to Moses Easterly, both of Greene co, TN, for \$1,000, 60 acres where Henry Burkhalter then lived, which was a part of a grant to Sears on 4 Feb 1794 by NC, on the north side of the Nolichucky River. Witnesses were Daniel Brunson and Henry Burkhalter[7-Greene co, TN Deed Book 10, pp 112-113].

On 1 Sep 1812, John L Sears sold to Anthony Bewley, both of Greene co, TN, for \$170, 211 acres on the north side of the Nolichucky River. Witnesses were Jacob Bewley, Robert A Ragan, and Mahlon Bewley[7- pp 86-87]

Blanche Keeney Stephens proved that John Sears who was in Hampshire and Hardy cos was the same man who later lived in Greene co, TN

In 1799, **Sears** signed a petition to carve Anderson co from Knox co, TN. John and James **Sears** were on the 1803 Knox co, KY tax roll. Only James **Sears** was present in 1802[14-Knox co Kinfolk, Jul 1985].

In 1810 Knox co, KY John **Sears** and wife, 26-45, had a boy under 10, one 10-16, a daughter 16-26, and three slaves. (Nearby were William, James, and Jesse **Sears**, each 26-45)[15-William Kozee, Pioneer Families of Eastern and Southeastern KY, Baltimore: Genealogical Pub Co, 1973. 1810 Knox co, KY census, p.65]

Among Tellico claims, Warrant #13, John **Sears** on 2 Oct 1810 had #388 survey for 170 acres in Knox co on Patterson Creek, surveyed 14 Jan 1814, granted on 12 Apr 1816. Jesse and William **Sears** on 17 Jul 1812 each and KY by virtue of a unique mark he used on instruments in the appropriate jurisdictions' it was a capital "I" with a cross line and a reversed capital "S". As Blanche put it, "Thank goodness for that mark and seal."

He and his wife were moved from TN to Knox co, KY by his children about 1813. He was on the 1819 tax list there, the only **Sears**. An injunction suit was filed in the Knox co Chancery Court about Oct 1821 by Peter **Wilson** against James **Sears**, administrator of John **Sears** estate, to prevent foreclosure on two notes **Wilson** had given to John **Sears**, his father in law[9-Sharon Mayne Withers, Lexington, KY wrote in Oct 1992 giving the results of her discovery at the KY State Library and Archives of the papers in this administration's defense against a suit by son in law Peter **Wilson** to offset his claims against notes held by the estate of John **Sears**. She is a descendant of Peter **Wilson** and Elizabeth **Sears**, William **Sears**, and Maryann **Sears** Sutton **Stanfield**].

received Knox co land on Cumberland River.

In 1816 - four years after the first entry was made there - **Sears** entered land in Orleans twp, Orange co, IN. (As did Christian Hostetler and William Kerr)[16-History of Lawrence, Orange and Washington co, IN, 1884] (Orange co, 20 by 20 miles, was carved from Washington co on 26 Dec 1815 and organized in Feb 1816. Orleans, the first town, was platted 11 Mar 1815. Orleans twp, organized with the county, extended into Old Lost River twp.; it was the best land and quickly settled. Orleans twp adjoins Lawrence co and Northeast twp)

In 1816, land was conveyed to **Sears** and other trustees of Orleans Methodist Church. On 7 Oct 1817, John and Nancy conveyed to son James Brock **Sears** a hundred acres of NW 1/4, Section 31, Twp 3, Range 1. She signed with an X. David **Green**, JP, and Samuel **Lewis** witenssed[17-Orange co, IN Deed Book A, p 88]. In 1817, **Sears** and William **Lindley** were viewers for the Paoli and Orleans road.

Sears took up 170 acres on Patterson Creek[19-Knox co, KY Surveyor's Book A, #13]. He made a power of attorney, on 15 Feb 1819, to Samuel **Cox**, Sr, to convey that land to Jesse **Sears**, of Pulaski co, KY[20-Whitley co, KY Deed Book 1, pp 364-5]. The deed was executed 9 Jan 1831.

John Sears m, second, Mary Elizabeth Stanfield. An overseer was appointed for "the Quaker road from Jonathan Jones to John Sears near Orleans."

In 1820 Orange co, John **Sears** was at least 45, his wife 26-45, a daughter was under 10 and one 10-16[21-1820 Orange co, IN Northeast twp, census, p 133. James B **Sears** was on p.131]

When the Methodists organized, in 1820, John and Mary **Sears** were original members. In 1822, as trustee, John helped build a log church. Patrons **Sears, Brooks, Webb**, and **Lewis**, in 1823, built the first school in Orleans, which was incorporated by 1829.

On 9 Jan 1831, John **Sears**, of Orange co, by attorney-in-fact Andrew **Craig-**through power derived from Samuel **Cox** of Whitley co - for \$400 sold 100 acres on Patterson creek to Jesse **Sears**, of Pulaski co[22-Whitley co, KY Deed Records, p 364].

Led by **Sears** and Joseph **Crawford**, in 1831, citizens built a 20 by 20 foot log schoolhouse, with glass windows, in Orleans. The **Sears** children were pupils[23-History of Orange co, Vol I, 1950]

In the 1840 census John **Sears** was 60-70 and his wife was 40-50, boy under 5, two 5-10, and one 15-20, girl 5-10, one 10-15, and one 15-20. (In Orleans town John W **Sears**, 40-50, had a son 10-15, a girl under 5, a female 40-50, one 50-60)[24-1840 Orange co, Orleans twp, IN census].

Sears d 18 May 1841. His Apr 1840 will, probated 19 Jun 1841, named children by first wife: James B Sears and Elizabeth, who m a "Gunton" (Gherton).

In 1838 **Sears** moved to a thousand acres (worth \$1.25 an acre) at Altona, Bates co and built a two-story, double log house.

On 25 May 1839, JBS and Jane sold Jennings **Beckwith** several Rives co lots for \$1,500. In Jun and Aug JBS platted land in Henry co.

On 28 Sep 1840, Francis A **Sears** sold to JBS, both of Van Buren co, MO, 40 acres in T 42, R 30 in present Bates co. (Francis had bought in 1839; he may have caused JBS, wife and 11 children to move there, to Section 33, Grand River twp)

On 23 Oct 1841, JBS sold land to J S Swift. On 27 Oct 1841 JBS sold land to Isaac F Swift. (Isaac Swift mortgaged land to Rebecca Prigmore, Isaiah's widow, on 20 Feb 1851.)[34-Henry co Deed Book D, pp 381, 384, Book E, p 332].

On 16 Mar 1842, JBS sold to Pleasant and George W Walker and sold land in T42, R30 to Franklin Sears.

In the 1820 Northeast twp, Orange co, IN census JBS and Jane, 16-25, had three boys and a girl under 10 and farmed near John **Sears**.

In 1827 he moved to Saline co, MO, where he was listed in the Nov 1830 census: #234 James B Sears, Arrow Rock twp, was on the page with Benjamin Jones, Nathaniel Walker (Jane's brother), Hardin Nave, George Nave, James and John Sappington, and William Beaty. Elizabeth Prigmore, mother of Daniel and Dorcas, was 8 pages away.

In 1831, **Sears** was an original settler of Rives co; brothers-in-law Pleasant and George W **Walker**, arrived in 1832. Formed in 1834 from Lafayette, Rives became Henry co in 1841[30-History of St Clair and Henry cos, MO, 1883, pp 114, 139, 140, 319].

On 4 Aug 1835 JBS was surety for Sheriff Joseph Fields.

A 2 Aug 1836 petition signed by **Seaers**, John Y **Sharp**, Peyton **Parks**, Charles C **Harris**, B F **Wallace**, Alfred **Jack**, Isaac **Swift**, John **Nave**, William **Swift**, Willis **Bush**, Fielding A **Pinnell**, Robert **Brown**, Moses **Stansberry**, G W **Lake**, and G W **Walker** sought a survey to widen the road from Johnson co line at the "high point of post oak thence running to a point designated for the present county seat of this county thence to continue south to the county of St Clair." In Nov, John M **Reid** and James B **Sears** reported on their survey[31-Henry co, MO Court Minute Book 1].

On 28 Nov 1836, Rives commissioners "ordered that James B Sears(deputy sheriff) be allowed \$8 for viewing and marking road from high point of Post Oak to the Osage River."

On 16 Jan 1837, John **Rank**, of Teabo twp, farmer, gave **Sears**, of Grand River twp, Henry co, a deed of trust on a wagon, 2 work horses, a sorrel mare, 3 yoke of oxen and a black mare.

In May 1837 **Sears**, John M **Reed**, and Willis **Bush** were election judges in Grand River twp. In Jun 1837 **Sears'** Clinton home was used as a courtroom, for which the county paid \$6 rent.

On 28 Mar 1838, **Sears** bought lots 15 and 16 in Clinton for \$74. The deeds were signed by John F **Sharp**, Commissioner [32-Henry co Deed Book A, p 70]. In Oct and Nov of 1838 **Sears** patented two parcels and a third of a half section with Pleasant and George **Walker**.

On 16 Nov 1838, **Sears** entered E 1/2 of SW 1/4 of S 3, T 41, T 26, per cash certificate 13,235, and patent was issued 1 May 1843, and signed by John **Tyler**.

The house believed to be the oldest in Clinton stood on this grant. JBS and Jane sold to Jennings **Beckwith** on 25 May 1839[33-Henry co Deed Book 29, p 167].

At the Apr 1842 term, these actions were filed in Cass co Circuit Court: Elias **Sears** v Robert **Davis** and Fleming **Davis**, trespass vi et armis; Fleming **Davis** v James B **Sears**; and Robert **Davis** v James B **Sears**, tresspass vi et armis.

At the Jul 1842 term a manslaughter indictment against James B Sears was deferred to the next term.

No **Sears** or **Prigmore** was on the 1845 Henry co tax roll except for Franklin's Lots 80 and 81[35-Betty Williams, Henry co, MO Assessor's Book, 1845-1977, Warrensburg, MO:1977].

On 13 Apr 1849, JBS, as attorney for Franklin Sears, sold two Clinton lots to Joseph **Reid**[36-Henry co Deed Book E, p 98]. In 1849 JBS d of cholera at Ft Kearney, NE en route to the CA gold fields. Jane, George, Sarah, and Minerva returned to live in S11, Shawnee twp, Bates co, MO.

Although not mentioned in T C Berry's "Across the Plains in 49,"

Sears may have belonged to that same party. Led by J C Hays, it probably left Pettis 19 Apr 1849 - the day Sears sold his land in Bates and Henry co. On 26 Apr, he sold the balance of Franklin's real estate. The 80 or 90 in the Berry party included Isaiah Prigmore - who died in Panama on his way home - and a Knaus.

After they left Independence, others joined. Crossing the state line on 1 May 1849 were 21 wagons with 7 men to the wagon - a total of 147. They reached the mines 1 Sep 1849.

In 1850 Cass co, #111 Jane Sears, 57, MD, Elias, MY, George, MO, Marinda, James A Sears, 4 months, MO.[37-1850 Cass co, MO census, p 67, #111].(#112 Mary Sears Prigmore; #72 Joseph and Rhodann Reeder; #109 Hiram and Jane Edwards; #110 Joel and Wealthy Sears.)

A letter, 16 Nov 1861, from Joseph G Walker, Saline co, MO, to Granville P Swift in CA:

Dear Granville I got to Lexington on the day that it was captured by **Price** and have seen two other small battles two days before I reached there-this country is in a deplorable fix not one half of the people can stay at home Aunt Jane **Sears** has had to take all her Negroes and leave and go to places of safety as best she could but as **Lane** the Cansus thief has been through that country I would not be surprised if he has not taken them all as he takes all that he can find-George I understand has had to stay in the brush all summer but has saved many a stroling son of a bitch in Saline co. When ever any stargling fellows come in the county they rarely get out-no property is saf from them but the God that made the people of the South will witness their independance when this war ends. I never in my life saw so much determined will to the object-in view I will go to Ark in a few days if I can get there; I have not got a letter from Wm. **Jones** since I arrived in Mo. You will see all in the newspapers; all are well at Bo Parires? -I don't know when I will get back to Calofornia No money or law in this country. My best wiches to all. Write and tell **Jones** to write to me.
