Dear Sears Family:

It's been a crazy year again for me. The Air Force cancelled the contract I was working on at Tinker AFB back in April so I have since started working for the FAA at Oklahoma City's airport. Our three girls are back in school, a high school senior, Junior high and one in elementary school. There just hasn't been much time for genealogy with job search and family duties.

Years ago I found reference to the Papers of Capt Peter Sears at the William L Clements Library, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. Since Capt Sears had no children of his own, it appears that he adopted his brother Roland's son, also named Peter. Solomon Fuller Sears is the son of the second Peter and lived on his father's homestead in Michigan. He came into custody of his grandfather Sears's papers and either Solomon or one of his children evidently gave them to the William L Clements Library. The manuscript curator has microfilmed all the papers and permitted me to publish some interesting items. The papers include account books, wills, certificates, bills of sale, etc.

Will of Capt Peter Sears [3770] (1743-1802)

In the Name of God Amen I Peter Sears of a hfield in the County of Hampshire and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Being weak in Body but of 'ound and perfect mind and xxx memory Do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following

-- -- -

First and Principally I give and Recommend my Soul to God that gave it and my Body to be buried at the discretion of of Executors hereafter named and as to such worldly Estate as it has pleased God to ble's me with I give and dispose of it in manner and form following -- -- --

first. I give to my Nephew Zachariah Sears Son to my Brother Rowland Sears my gold Sleeve Buttons –

Secondly I give to my apprintice Boy Zepheniah Baker a cow or the value of a cow in mony when he shall be twenty one years of age.

Thirdly I give to my beloved wife thankful Sears the Remainder of my Personal Estate not above disposed of after my Debts Legaces and funeral Charges are paid out to be at her own Disposal and the Improvement of all my Real and Lease hold Estate So long as she shall Remain my widow -- -- --

Fourthly I give to my Nephew Peter Sears Son to my Brother Rowland Sears all me Real and lease hold Estate when he shall arive at the age of twenty years provided my wife should either die or marry before that time and if she should not at the time of her death or marrage to him his Heirs and a signs provided he live to the age of twenty one years and if he Should die before he shall arive at the age of twenty one years then my will is that said Estate shall go to my Brother Rowlands oldest Son which he shall then have libing and if my wife either die or marry befre the said Peter Sears shall be twenty one years of age my will is that my Executor improve said Estate the Incomes of it to be paid to the said Peter Sears when he shall arive to the age of twenty one years or to oldest Brother who shall come into Posse'sion of said Estate as above disposed of Lastly I do constitute and appoint my Brother Rowland Sears and my Nephew the said Peter Sears Executors to this my last will and testament -- --

In witne's where of I have here unto set my hand and Seal this twenty fourth day of april in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two -- -- Singed Sealed published and declared by the above named Peter Sears to be his last will and testament in Presence of us

of said A'hfield deceased being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory Do make an publih this my last will and Testament in manner, and form, following, Viz I give and recommend my soul to God who gave it, and my Body to the ground to be buried at the discretion of my Executors Hereafter named, and as touching such Worldly estate as it has pleased God to ble's me with, I give and dispose of it in manner and form following, that is to say, First, I give to Peter Sears Son to my brother in law Joseph Sears of Dennis, in the county of barnstable Forty dollars to be paid him when he shall be twenty one ears of age I do also give to Zephaniah Baker formerly an indented servant to my late Husband, twenty dollars, I also give to Eunice Hall the Wife of Jesse Hall, and Jerusha Howes the daughters of my brother Thomas Howes deceased, and Dinah Howes the Wife of nehemiah Howes all of them of dennis in the County Barnstable to these three all of my wearing apparel not otherwise disposed of in this Will, and my trunk to be equally divided between them, I do also give to the abovementioned Eunice Hall my gold Sleevebuttons—I also give to the abovementioned Jerusha Howes one Silver spoon marked H.I.T. and also two Coverlids I do also give to the aforementioned dinah Howes one bed and two pair of sheets, and also my best woolen bedquilt, I also give to Thankful Sears daughter to Peter Sears my gold beads and lastly I give to Peter Sears, of a hfield Son to my Brother in Law Rowland Sears, all the remainder of my estate of what kind as nature sooner not above disposed of after my just Legacies & funeral charges are paid out to him his heirs and a signs & I alo also appoint him the said Peter Sears sole executor of this my last will & testament, In witne's whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the tenth day of march in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten.

Thankful Sears to be her last will and testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names and as witne's in the [presence of the testator]

Will of Zachariah Sears [2517] (1706-1796)

Fishing Report

Report From Capt Nathan Crowell to Peter Sears of progress of a fishing and trading voyage to the grand bank and France.

[page 1] Nantes October 20th 1795: Sir I take this opertunity to Inform you that We Arived att the port of Nantes the Ninth day of October all in Good Health We was three months on the Grand banks fi'h Being Very Scarce and have had twenty Eight Days palage from thence to this port to A poor market for our cargo. all though the Market is Not so poor as has Been the Market pri2e has Been from too to three dollar per Quentel Not Any Ben sold for More than three Dollars per Quentel att this port their has Been Sold att this port A Nomber of Cargos But their is Not a Ve'sel With fi'h in this port But us But Likely Will Bee Soon I have had four dollars offerd per Quentel But I hold them att five But if their Should Come in Several Ve'sels With fi'h I may Be Glad to take three dollars We have Sold But About thirty Quentels them We Retailed By pairs and Quentels they have turnd out

But About five dollars per Quentel We took on Bord Sixteen thou and fi h Which I Expect Will Be About five hundred Quentels a?it is Got to Bee Late in the Season I think I shall Lye and Retail my Fi'h Except I can have four dollars and an half therefore you Nead Not Look for us untill the fir?t of March I Advise Levi to Ship his Crew for this Schoner as I Wish Not to take charge My Self if I Should Sell My Cargo Soon I dont Now But I Shall take A frait from hear to Some other port in france As their is plenty of them to Be had [page 21 I Saw Capt Garth Berry hear from haverdegrace and has took A frait and Bound to oftend Spile is Scarce and and paper Money I due Not take as it is depre lated So Low But their is Brandy to Be had for fish or Cash all though it is Sumwhat high as to Na Ional Afairs I Shall Not Men Ion all traid is Very Very poor and dull in all parts of france I Believe that this port is as good for our Cargo as Any part of france as I have Na% from Mo?t all parts But it is poor hear I Shall Leave the Remainder out until1 A Better opertunity So I Remain yours Nathan Crowell [reverse] To Capt Peter Sear of Cape Cod att Dennis
